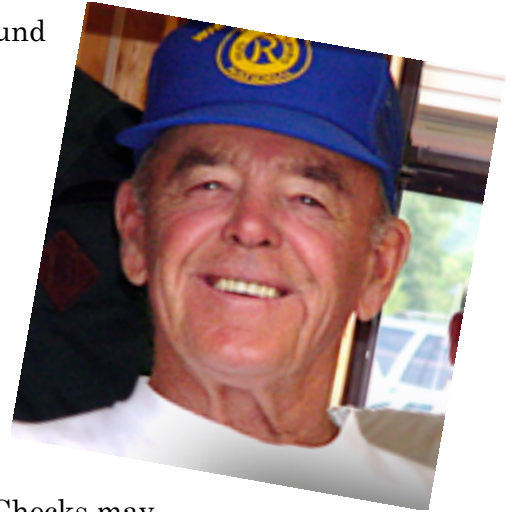
Dan Maupin White Hall Ruritan Scholarship Fund

Grants from the Dan Maupin White Hall Ruritan Scholarship Fund **will benefit area high school graduates continuing their education.** Recipients are chosen annually by the Education Committee of White Hall Ruritan Club on the basis of student merit and need.

The scholarship fund *honors Dan Maupin*, founding member in 1962 of White Hall Ruritan Club and a continuing active member of the club and resident of White Hall, Virginia.

Donations are tax deductible, and an acknowledgment for IRS purposes will be sent promptly to the donor by the Ruritan National Foundation.

Make checks out to: Ruritan National Foundation, with a note on the memo line saying "Dan Maupin Scholarship Fund." The Fund is being established at a minimum size of \$20,000 and invested through Ruritan National Foundation. The Foundation guarantees a minimum return of 5% annually, with any higher investment returns benefiting the principal of the endowment.

These favorable terms enable the Dan Maupin Fund to start making annual scholarship grants of \$1,000, with larger grants in later years as the principal value of the Fund grows through further donations and investment returns.

As of December 2009, White Hall Ruritan Club has raised over \$17,400, including seed money donations from individual club members of over \$12,400 and a donation of \$5,000 by the club from its financial reserve. **The club matches your donation one- to-one, up to a total of at least \$15,000.**

The website www.whitehallva.org documents the agreement between White Hall Ruritan Club and the Ruritan National Foundation regarding the Dan Maupin White Hall Ruritan Scholarship Fund. Donors are acknowledged on this website and future activities of the Dan Maupin Scholarship Fund will be chronicled there.
